

We're Accessible!

By coach:

• Located "inside the Beltway" (I-495 and I-95), Arlington is easily accessible from I-66, I-395 and U.S. Routes 1, 29 and 50.

By air:

• International flights: Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD), located 20 miles west of Arlington, and Baltimore/Washington

International Airport (BWI), located 37 miles northeast of Arlington

• *Domestic U.S. travel*: Reagan National Airport (DCA), located in Arlington

By rail:

Arlington is connected via the region's Metro system to national rail service (Amtrak) at Union Station in Washington, D.C.



Arlington's Metro-centered urban villages are hip and full of energy while at the same time fresh and welcoming.

- **Ballston** is home to the MedStar Capitals Iceplex, where your groups can participate in figure skating, ice hockey and skating lessons on either of two large rinks, or watch the Washington Capitals practice "live" in season. Check out the new Ballston Quarter!
- Clarendon has restaurants galore, great sidewalk dining and main street shopping.
- Crystal City has Arlington's largest concentration of hotels along with access to walking trails, outdoor parks and energetic dining, shopping and culture. Crystal City and nearby Pentagon City are also home to National Landing and Amazon HQ2!
- **Pentagon City** has abundant shopping with the expanded Fashion Centre at Pentagon City, as well as Pentagon Row and Pentagon Centre. The neighborhood is also home to historic sites such as the National 9/11 Pentagon Memorial and the Air Force Memorial. Check out the newly renovated DEA Museum & Visitors Center!
- **Rosslyn** presents panoramic views of D.C., the Marine Corps War Memorial (Iwo Jima), Arlington National Cemetery, Military Women's Memorial and Arlington House. **Rosslyn is also home to Nestlé HQ!**
- **Shirlington** features Tony Award®-winning Signature Theatre, whose open atrium overlooks more than 30 charming neighborhood stores and restaurants along an outdoor promenade.
